



1. Head & leg




Twist 2/3 pipe cleaners to make body skeleton

5. To make her hair:




for men - wrap wool around 2/3 fingers.




Wrap pipe cleaners with wadding. Tie with thread.

6. cut circle into lengths. Tie in the middle with thread of same colour.




Tie joints tightly. Add extra wadding to shape breasts/hips or shoulders

7. sew the centre in the middle or on the side.




cover the whole head with wool. sew each woolen thread around the hair line.

cut out 2x shapes of doll. Sew to fit very snugly. stretch material doubled. leave side open to insert doll. Sew closed by hand.

8. Repeat step 5 & 6.




Sew only on centre, hair-line in front and on crown. leave long hair loose. cut to the same length.

# Making Rag Dolls



### Outline of ragdoll body.

Lay your own doll on double layer of stretch skin-coloured material. Draw closely around the body. Cut out. Sew 2 pieces together. Turn in.



Leave the side open to insert doll. Hand sew this section closed.

(The 'skin' must fit snugly.)


This is the size of our women dolls. The men are a little taller.






Please note: all patterns are conceptual + must be adjusted to fit your doll. Most these patterns were drawn and made by my 10 year old daughter Miss.K.


### Faces







sew centre backs. open and attach at neck back.



Step 1. sew crown to make circle

2. sew crown on to hat top

Sun Hat crown - Fold in half lengthways

3. attach brim to crown base.
