Instructions given for 41 cm. (16 inch) Chest, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

Use only the Peter Pan yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated.

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

K. – Knit; P. – Purl; st(s). – stitch(es); st.st. – stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl); g.st. – garter stitch (every row knit); inc. – increase; dec. – decrease; rept. – repeat; beg. – beginning; alt. – alternate; tog. – together; sl.1 – slip one; p.s.s.o. – pass slipped stitch over; y.fwd. – yarn forward; m.1 – make one, pick up loop before next st. and K. or P. it through back of loop; O – No stitches or rows to be worked in that particular size; patt. – pattern; cm. – centimetres; ins. – inches.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment.

28 sts. and 36 rows to 10 cm. (4 ins.) over Lacy Patt. or st.st. on 3¼ mm. Needles.

If there are too many stitches to 10 cm., then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10 cm., then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

LACY DESIGN

BACK

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 61 (69, 75, 83, 89) sts.

Commence Patt.

1st Row (Right Side) – Knit.

2nd and Alt. Rows – Purl.

3rd Row – K.5 (1, 4, 8, 3), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * to last 0 (4, 7, 3, 6) sts., K.0 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.1) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.4) (K.3) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.3).

5th Row – K.6 (2, 5, 9, 4), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * to last 7 (3, 6, 2, 5) sts., y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4) (K.2) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3).

7th Row – Knit.

9th Row – K.1 (5, 8, 4, 7), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * to last 4 (0, 3, 7, 2) sts., y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.1 (K.0) (K.3) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.4) (K.2).

11th Row – K.2 (6, 9, 5, 8), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * to

last 3 (7, 2, 6, 1) sts., y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5) (K.2) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4) (K.1).

12th Row – Purl.

These 12 rows form the patt.

Continue in patt. until Back measures 9.5 (11, 12, 13.5, 16.5) cm. 3¾ (4¼, 4¾, 5¼, 6½) ins. from commencement finishing on a 10th (2nd, 6th, 12th, 10th) patt. row.

Shape Armholes

Keeping patt. correct.

Cast off 6 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. 49 (57, 63, 71, 77) sts.

Continue without further shaping until armholes measure 9 (10, 11.5, 12.5, 14) cm. 3½ (4, 4½, 5, 5½) ins. finishing on a wrong side row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 13 (16, 16, 19, 20) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Cast off remaining 23 (25, 31, 33, 37) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 10 (14, 17, 21, 24) sts.

Commence Patt.

1st Row (Right Side) – K. to end, cast on 4 sts. at end of row.

2nd Row – Purl.

3rd Row – K.5 (1, 4, 8, 3), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * 0 (1, 1, 1, 2) times more, K.1, cast on 4 sts. at end of row. 18 (22, 25, 29, 32) sts.

4th Row – Purl.

5th Row – K.6 (2, 5, 9, 4), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * 0 (1, 1, 1, 2) times more, K.3, m.1, K.1.

6th Row – P.1, m.1, P. to end.

7th Row – K. to last st., m.1, K.1.

8th Row – As 6th Row.

9th Row – K.1 (5, 8, 4, 7), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * 1 (1, 1, 2) times more, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.1, m.1, K.1.

10th Row – Purl.

11th Row – K.2 (6, 9, 5, 8), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * to

1 (1, 1, 2, 2) times more, y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.2, m.1, K.1. 24 (28, 31, 35, 38) sts.

12th Row – Purl.

Continue in patt. as set and working all inc. sts. into patt., inc. 1 st. at shaped edge as before on the next and every following alt. row until 27 (31, 34, 38, 41) sts. are on the needle.

Continue without further inc. until Front measures same as Back to armholes finishing on a same patt. row.

Shape Armhole and Front

Keeping patt. correct.

Next Row – Cast off 6 sts., patt. to last 2 sts., dec. 1 st.

Work 1 row.

** Keeping armhole edge straight, dec. 1 st. at Front edge on the next and every following alt. row until 17 (21, 19, 23, 24) sts., then on every following 4th row until 13 (16, 16, 19, 20) sts. remain.

Continue without further shaping until armhole measures same as Back to shoulders finishing at armhole edge.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off remaining 13 (16, 16, 19, 20) sts.**

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 10 (14, 17, 21, 24) sts.

Commence Patt.

1st Row (Right Side) – Knit.

2nd Row – P. to end, cast on 4 sts. at end of row.

3rd Row – K.6, * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * 0 (0, 0, 1, 1) times more, K.0 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.1) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.4) (K.3) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.3).

4th Row – P. to end, cast on 4 sts. at end of row. 18 (22, 25, 29, 32) sts.

5th Row – Inc. in first st., K.2, * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * 0 (1, 1, 2, 2) times more, y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4.) (K.2) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3).

6th Row – P. to last st., m.1, P.1.

7th Row – K.1, m.1, K. to end.

8th Row – As 6th Row.

9th Row – K.1, m.1, K.1, * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * 1 (2, 2, 2, 3) times more, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.1 (K.0) (K.3) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.4) (K.2).

10th Row – Purl.

11th Row – K.1, m.1, K.3, * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * 1 (1, 2, 2, 3) times more, y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5) (K.2) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4) (K.1). 24 (28, 31, 35, 38) sts.

12th Row – Purl.

Continue in patt. as set and working all inc. sts. into patt., inc. 1 st. at shaped edge as before on the next and every following alt. row until 27 (31, 34, 38, 41) sts. are on the needle.

Continue without further inc. until Front measures same as Back to armholes finishing on a same patt. row.

Shape Front and Armhole

Keeping patt. correct.

Next Row – Dec. 1 st., patt. to end.

Next Row – Cast off 6 sts., patt. to end.

Work as instructions given for Left Front from ** to **.

SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 2¾ mm. Needles, cast on 35 (39, 41, 43, 45) sts.

1st Row – K.1, * P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

2nd Row – P.1, * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to end.

Rept. the last 2 rows for 2.5 cm. (1 inch) finishing on a 1st Row.

Next Row (Inc. Row) – Rib 5 (4, 6, 3, 4), inc. in next st., * rib 7 (5, 3, 3, 3), inc. in next st., rept. from * to last 5 (4, 6, 3, 4) sts., rib to end. 39 (45, 49, 53, 55) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm. Needles.

Commence Patt.

1st Row – Knit.

2nd and Alt. Rows – Purl.

3rd Row K.2 (5, 7, 1, 2), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * to last 5 (0, 2, 4, 5) sts., y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.2 (K.0) (K.2) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.1) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.2).

5th Row – K.3 (6, 8, 2, 3), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * to last 4 (7, 1, 3, 4) sts., y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.2 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1,

p.s.s.o., K.5) (K.1) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.2).

7th Row – Inc. in first st., K. to last st., inc. in last st.

9th Row – K.7 (2, 4, 6, 7), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.5, rept. from * to last 2 (5, 7, 1, 2) sts., K.2 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.2) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.4) (K.1) (K.2).

11th Row – K.8 (3, 5, 7, 8), * y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6, rept. from * to last 1 (4, 6, 0, 1) sts., K.1 (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.2) (y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4) (K.0) (K.1).

12th Row – Purl.

Continue in patt. as set and working all inc. sts. into patt., inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following 8 (6, 6, 6, 6)th row until 49 (53, 63, 67, 77) sts. are on the needle.

(46, 56) cm. (18, 22) inch sizes only

Inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on every following 8th row until (57, 71) sts. are on the needle.

All Sizes

Continue without further inc. until Sleeve measures 16.5 (17.5, 19, 24, 26.5) cm. 6½ (7, 7½, 9½, 10½) ins. from commencement finishing on a 2nd (6th, 10th, 4th, 2nd) patt. row. Mark each end of last row with a coloured thread.

Work a further 8 rows in patt. for Sleeve extension finishing on a 10th (2nd, 6th, 12th, 10th) patt. row. Cast off.

PLAIN DESIGN

BACK

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 61 (69, 75, 83, 89) sts.

Work in st.st. until Back measures 9.5 (11, 12, 13.5, 16.5) cm. 3¾ (4¼, 4¾, 5¼, 6½) ins. from commencement finishing on a P. row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 6 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. 49 (57, 63, 71, 77) sts.

Continue without further shaping until armholes measure 9 (10, 11.5, 12.5, 14) cm. 3½ (4, 4½, 5, 5½) ins. finishing on a P. row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 13 (16, 16, 19, 20) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Cast off remaining 23 (25, 31, 33, 37) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 10 (14, 17, 21, 24) sts.

1st Row (Right Side) – K. to end, cast on 4 sts. at end of row.

2nd Row – Purl.

Rept. the 1st and 2nd Rows once more. 18 (22, 25, 29, 32) sts.

Next Row – K. to last st., m.1, K.1.

Next Row – P.1, m.1, P. to end.

Continue in st.st., inc. 1 st. at shaped edge as before on every row until 23 (27, 30, 34, 37) sts., then on every following alt. row until 27 (31, 34, 38, 41) sts. are on the needle. Continue without further inc. until Front measures same as Back to armholes finishing on a P. row.

Shape Armhole and Front

Next Row – Cast off 6 sts., K. to last st., dec. 1 st.

Purl 1 row.

Work as instructions given for Left Front of Lacy Design from ** to **

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 10 (14, 17, 21, 24) sts.

1st Row (Right Side) – Knit.

2nd Row – P. to end, cast on 4 sts. at end of row.

Rept. the 1st and 2nd Rows once more. 18 (22, 25, 29, 32) sts.

Next Row – Inc. in first st., K. to end.

Next Row – P. to last st., m.1, P.1.

Continue in st.st., inc 1 st. at shaped edge as before on every row until 23 (27, 30, 34, 37) sts., then on

every following alt. row until 27 (31, 34, 38, 41) sts. are on the needle. Continue without further inc. until Front measures same as Back to armholes finishing on a P. row.

Shape Front and Armhole

Next Row – Dec. 1 st., K. to end.

Next Row – Cast off 6 sts., P. to end.

Work as instructions given for Left Front of Lacy Design from ** to **.

SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 2¾ mm. Needles, cast on 35 (39, 41, 43, 45) sts.

Work 2.5 cm. (1 inch) in rib as given for Sleeves of Lacy Design finishing on a 1st Row.

Next Row (Inc. Row) – Rib 5 (4, 6, 3, 4), inc. in next st., * rib 7 (5, 3, 3, 3), inc. in next st., rept. from * to last 5 (4, 6, 3, 4) sts., rib to end. 39 (45, 49, 53, 55) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm. Needles.

Continue in st.st., inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the 7th and every following 6th row until 43 (53, 63, 67, 77) sts. are on the needle.

41 (46, 56) cm. 16 (18, 22) inch sizes only

Inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on every following 8th row until 49 (57, 71) sts. are on the needle.

All Sizes

Continue without further inc. until Sleeve measures 16.5 (17.5, 19, 24,

26.5) cm. 6½ (7, 7½, 9½, 10½) ins. from commencement finishing on a P. row.

Mark each end of last row with a coloured thread.

Work a further 8 rows for Sleeve extension.

Cast off.

PRESSING

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given. Press as instructions.

MAKING UP BOTH DESIGNS

Join shoulder and side seams by backstitching.

Band

Using 2¾ mm. Needles, cast on 7 sts. Work in g.st. until band is long enough when slightly stretched to fit along lower edge of left front, up left front, across back neck, down right front and along lower edges of right front and back finishing at left side seam.

Cast off.

Pin band into position, sew on by top sewing.

Join sleeve seams to markers by backstitching omitting rib, join rib by top sewing.

Pin sleeves into position placing sleeve extension to cast off sts. at underarm, sew in by backstitching. Press seams.
